

Public Transport Guide

RIO 2016 Olympic Games São Paulo, Cidade do Futebol

São Paulo is one of the host cities for the RIO 2016 Olympic Games and will host 10 soccer matches at the Corinthians Arena in Itaquera, east of the city, from August 3rd to 19th, 6 women's and 4 men's, including a men's semi-final and a women's bronze medal dispute.

Accessing Corinthians Arena

The best ways to access the Corinthians Arena using public transport are:



METROPOLITAN EXPRESS TRAIN (CPTM) - Line 11 - Coral

On match days, an Express train will be available at line 11 - Coral, departing from Luz to Corinthians-Itaquera Station non-stop. This service will start three hours before the matches, departing from platform 4, with an approximately 19 minutes journey.

On August 10th and 12th (Wednesday and Friday, respectively) days when matches will start at 7am, the Express train will work from 2pm to 5pm. From 5pm to 7pm, the trains will work on regular daily services (with stops).

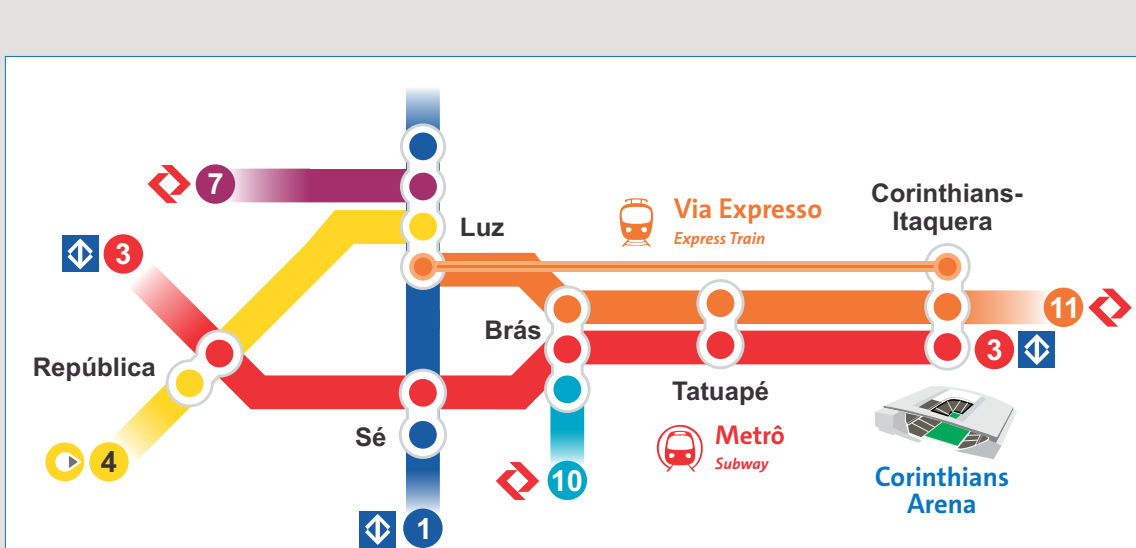
- **OPERATION:** the train stations (CPTM) opens from Sunday to Friday, 4am to midnight. On Saturday from 4am to Sunday 1am (Sunday).
- **TICKET PRICE:** R\$ 3,80



METRO - Line 3 - Red and Line 4 - Yellow

Metro will operate normally on match days. The best way to access the Arena is by Line 3 - Red, destination: Corinthians-Itaquera Station. Departing from Line 4 Yellow, it is possible to make a transfer at the República Station to Line 3 - Red or make a transfer in the Luz Station to Express Train Line 11-Coral CPTM.

- **OPERATION:** the Metro stations open from Sunday to Friday at 4-40am until midnight. On Saturdays from 4-40am to Sunday 1am.
- **TICKET PRICE:** R\$ 3,80



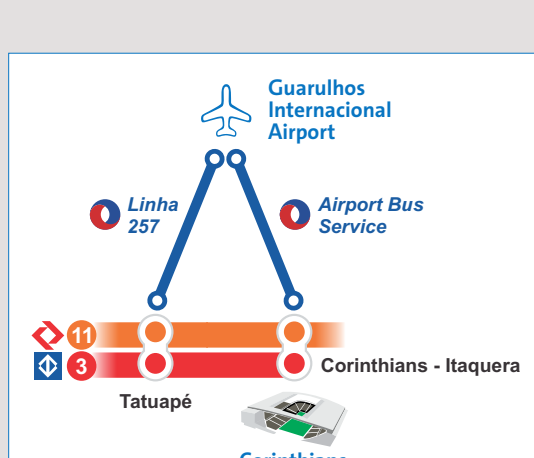
AIRPORT BUS SERVICE

Special Bus Line: From Guarulhos International Airport (Terminal 2) straight to Corinthians-Itaquera Bus Station (Platform E). Service available only on match days beginning 3 hours before the event.

- **TICKET PRICE:** R\$ 45,50

Line 257: From Guarulhos International Airport (Terminal 2) to Tatuapé Station (North Bus Station Terminal).

- **TICKET PRICE:** R\$ 5,55



MUNICIPAL AND INTERMUNICIPAL BUSES

You can also access the Arena, using 71 municipal lines (operated by SPTrans) and intercity lines (operated by EMTU) arriving at Itaquera Bus Terminal or through connections with train lines and subway on metropolitan area.

Remember to buy your round trip ticket in advance.

You save time and avoid unnecessary queues at ticket office.
